PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Safe Home Information and Support Program offers 24 hours, 7 days a week free and confidential information, support, and /or emergency shelter to self-identifying women and their dependents who are at risk of or who have experienced any type of violence over their lifetime.

We also encourage general inquiries from anyone by phone or email.

THE SERVICES WE PROVIDE

- Information on programs and services provided by RVCS and other available supports within the community.
- Assistance for self-identified females and their dependents fleeing violence.
- Referrals to our other anti-violence programs:
 - o Stopping the Violence Counselling
 - o Stopping the Violence Outreach
 - o PEACE Program
 - o Police Based Victim Services
 - Sexual Assault Response Program

WHAT TO EXPECT

• Client-centered, trauma-informed approach that best meet client needs.

When Staying in the Safe Home

- Safe, secure appropriate sleeping accommodations.
- Access to laundry facilities, food and infant formal if required.
- Respect for a woman's right to make choices based on her own understanding of her options, needs and goals.
- Respect for the individual situation, perspective and needs of the selfidentified women

ENDING SERVICES

- Services may be concluded for a variety of reasons, including the client has declined services or the client has left the safe home.
- Clients can always reach-out for services again.
