# ROOTS OF LIFE CHILDCARE

## Program Information

Roots of Life Childcare Centre in Valemount consists of various services including Multi-Age for children 0-12 years, School-Aged care for children up to 12 years, and Group childcare for children 30 months to school age.

### THE SERVICES WE PROVIDE

**Multiage childcare:** services operate from 8:00 am-5:00 pm Monday to Friday to children from ages 0 –12 years old. The time frame that children attend is optional. This space operates as a full-day daycare, providing children more opportunities to explore through play while operating on a flexible schedule to suit family needs.

**Group Care:** services operate from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. This program is offered to children 30 months to school age. Families can choose to enroll in any or all of the listed days of operation for this program. Group care takes place during a shorter time frame and is structured to be activity-based, incorporating different themed programming throughout the year.

**School age childcare:** services operate from 2:30 am to 5:00 pm after school, and 8:00 am to 5:00 pm on Mondays and Fridays during elementary school Pro-D Days, and through the months of July and August. This space will be open for children school-aged up to 12 years.

### HOW TO ACCESS OUR SERVICES

- Drop by our centre or call to be added to a waitlist, or to complete a registration form if there is no waitlist.
- Registration packages and further information may be obtained by calling the main office, or emailing requests to [childcare@rvcsbc.org](mailto:childcare@rvcsbc.org).
- If on a waitlist, a registration form can be completed to speed up the process if a space opens up.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Inclusive, child-centered care that fosters connection to the land and indigenous teachings, enriching children's development while embracing the whole child: mind, body and spirit.
- A continuity of care that is transparent and trauma-informed, using a collaborative approach between facility, families, and community with open and regular communication to ensure the success of all children.
- Inspire children to build confident independence through self-discovery.
- Certified educators will schedule children in spaces in accordance with availability and in consideration of the families requested times. Families will be contacted with spaces and times available.
- Collaboration between other professionals such as the CDC therapists and SCD to support children with overall development as needed.

### ENDING SERVICES

- Services may conclude for a variety of reasons, which include, but are not limited to, changing of programs, relocation, no longer needing services, and in exceptional instances termination by staff as required.
- Communication between staff and family will be maintained throughout the process of ending services.
