Job Summary

The focus on the program is facilitating, planning, organizing, and implementing community-based recreational, social and/or educational activities, programs and events. The position requires the ability to work independently, and alongside other program staff, volunteers and under supervision. Creative ideas, approaches and innovation is always appreciated. Direction and delegation of tasks as required from the leadership team.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

- Plans, organizes, implements, and facilitates fun, recreational, social and/or educational activities in the community.
- Encourages and facilitates clients' participation in activities; provides guidance and instructions.
- Monitors and observes clients' behaviour. Report problems to the supervisor.
- Provides skill building to clients such as life skills and social skills; models appropriate behaviour.
